OUTSIDE WATERING

Although Eureka City has not placed any restrictions on outside watering yet during this time of drought, they would like the citizens to be mindful of the current watering schedule that was set by Resolution several years ago. By following this schedule and watering times, it will help alleviate stress on our current water levels so we do not have to put restrictions on water use. The Council will readdress this at their next City Council Meeting on July 11, 2022.

The current watering schedule is listed below:

A The Time-of-Day **A** Watering Parameters are:

- * Sprinkler irrigation of all lawns and landscapes is *prohibited* between the hours of 9am and 7pm.
- * North Side of Town:

(Monday, Wednesday & Friday)

* South Side of Town:

(Tuesday, Thursday & Saturday)

* No Watering on Sunday Permitted.






