As per Eureka City Ordinance No 06-14-21-1, An Ordinance amending the City's Ordinance regulating the licensing and control of dogs and other animals within Eureka City - Section 13-244 Licensing Requirements

- It is unlawful for any person to keep, harbor or maintain any dog or cat six or more months old unless such animal has been registered and licensed with Eureka City.
- Kennel Licenses are required for anyone that has 3 or more dogs over the age of 3 months.

Eureka City News

Eureka City Council recently passed 3 new ordinances at a Special Council Meeting held on April 24, 2024.

A public hearing was held prior to the meeting to discuss and take public comment on the following:

1. Consider adopting amendments to the Cottage Home Ordinance, to include Twin Homes (those that meet the required parameters) as an allowed use.
2. Consider adopting amendment to the Eureka City Zoning Ordinance(s), to allow Twin Homes to be developed upon non-conforming lots only, as well as provide for further definitions.
3. Consider adopting an Ordinance to impose a 0.30% Sales and Use Tax for Transportation.
4. Consider adopting an Ordinance to impose a one percent Municipal Transient Room Tax.

Citizens in attendance voiced their concerns and opposition to the amendments concerning allowing the

Twin Homes, but favored the Ordinances imposing the taxes for both the Sales and Use Tax for Transportation and the Municipal Transient Room Tax.

During the Special Council Meeting, the Council voted 3 to 2, to adopt Ordinance No. 2024-04-24-01, an Amendment to the Cottage Home Ordinance to include Twin Homes (those that meet the required parameters) as an allowed use.

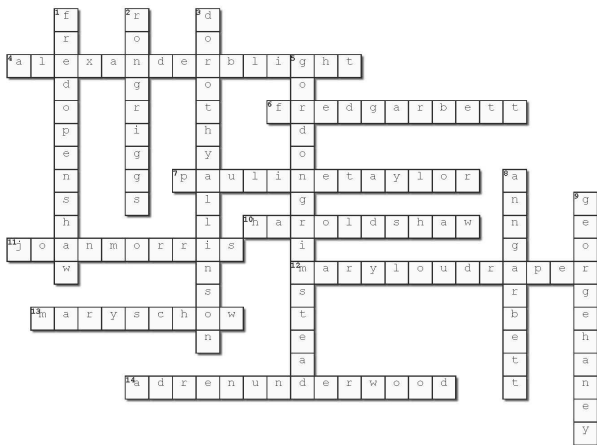
The Council discussed, but did not bring to a vote to adopt an amendment to the Eureka City Zoning Ordinance. They decided it would only be allowed in the Cottage Home Ordinance.

The Council also voted unanimously to adopt Ordinance No 2024-04-24-02, An Ordinance to impose a 0.30% Sales and Use Tax for Transportation, and to adopt Ordinance No. 2024-04-24-03 to impose a one percent Municipal Transient Room Tax.

Ordinances will be available for citizens to review at the City Office, and will be placed on the city website under Ordinances, Resolutions and Proclamations.

Who: Anyone and Everyone!!

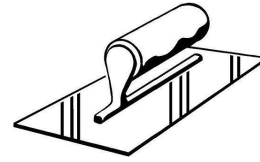
What: Books for young children, school-aged children, young adults, and adults.

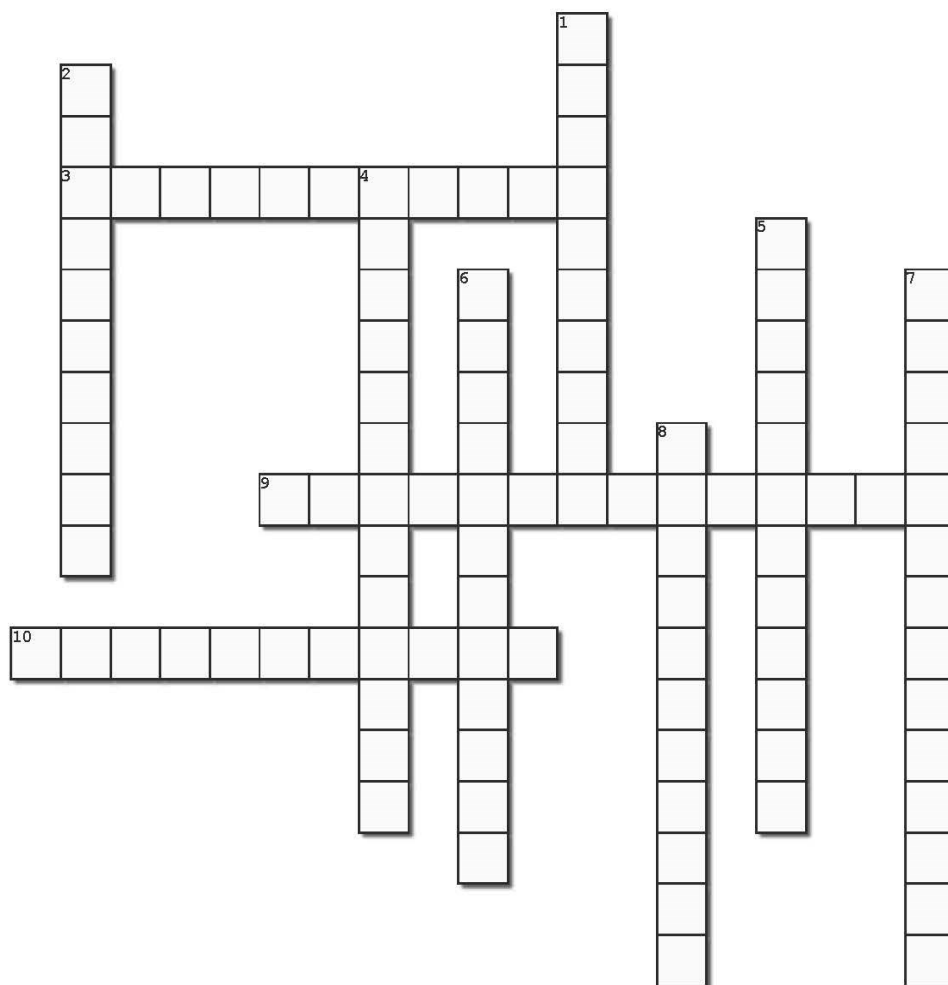
