

ORDINANCE NO. 08-08-2017-01

AN ORDINANCE ENACTING CLASSIFICATIONS OF RECORDS FOR EUREKA CITY UNDER THE GOVERNMENT RECORDS ACCESS AND MANAGEMENT ACT.

WHEREAS, the City of Eureka desires to classify records pursuant to §63G-2-101 et. seq. of the Utah State Code; and

WHEREAS, Title 63G Chapter 2 and § 10-8-84 of the Utah Code authorizes the City Council to pass ordinances which are reasonably and appropriately related to the providing for the public health, safety, morals, convenience, order, prosperity, and general welfare of the City and its residents;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF EUREKA CITY, THAT THE FOLLOWING ORDINANCE BE ADOPTED AS FOLLOWS:

I. Short Title

This chapter is known as the "Eureka City Government Records Access and Management Act."

II. Purpose And Intent

A. It is the intent of the city to:

1. Establish fair information practices to prevent abuse of personal information by the city while protecting the public's right of easy and reasonable access to unrestricted public records; and
2. Provide guidelines of openness to government information and privacy of personal information consistent with nationwide standards

III. State Government Records Access and Management Act Adopted

Except insofar as the application thereof is clearly impractical or inappropriate, in view of the context of purposes or penalty as provided, all of the definitions, requirements, regulations, prohibitions, provisions and sections of the Utah Government Records Access and Management Act, as amended, in Utah Code 63G-2-101 et. seq., are hereby adopted by the city.

IV. Severability

If any provisions or clause of this chapter or its application thereof to any person or circumstances is held to be unconstitutional or otherwise invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity shall not affect other sections, provisions, clauses, or applications which can be implemented without the invalid provision, clause, or application. To this end, the provisions of this chapter are declared to be severable.

V. Effective Date

This ordinance shall become effective on the date passed by the City Council of Eureka.
