DISCUSSION ITEMS

Budget for FY Ending June 30, 2026.

The Council discussed the 2026 budget, emphasizing the need to finalize it by the June meeting. Key points included the necessity of notifying the Utah Tax Commission by June 1 for Truth in Taxation. Attorney Christopherson suggested instead of going line by line to use the tentative budget as a guide and address the differences or changes that have been added to or increased. This should make it easier to put the budget together. The Council reviewed actual vs. proposed budget figures, noting discrepancies in revenue and expenditures. They also discussed potential reallocations, and the need for a \$100 monthly raise for Council Members. Attorney Christopherson informed the Council that a specific Public Hearing addressing increasing the Council's stipend is required. The Council debated the allocation of funds for water repairs, fire hydrants, and the Memorial Building, and capital projects list.

Mayor Dever said she and her husband met with Brandon Mellor from the Utah Division of Water Rights about the meter issues discussed at the last meeting. He would like to have a meter on the city ballfields. She took pictures of the wells and had them available for him to review. He was very obliging and changed the 2021, 2022, 2023, 2024, water reports. It was a very good meeting and everything is taken care of. She asked about the bookmobile invoice for the school. Recorder Bigler stated she contacted our contact with the bookmobile. Because the contract is with the city it will be up to us to invoice the school. This information was never given to her or Rachel. An invoice will need to be created and sent to the school. Mayor Dever said before building permits are issued the soil report must be given to the city. Recorder Bigler said this is being done and the report is uploaded to the iWorQ system.
